*Item 80 – Method for Submission of Forwarding Instructions, to Release Empty Railcars, and Date and time Record on Notification*

TSR will accept forwarding instructions through one of three methods at no charge: i) ShipperConnect; ii) a Class I website; or iii) by making arrangements directly with third party logistics services providers to submit forwarding instructions on their behalf via a Class I website or via EDI. For customers on the TSR, we will accept forwarding instructions via email ([srohal@thewesterngroup.net](mailto:srohal@thewesterngroup.net)) with a copy to ([greg@thewesterngroup.net](mailto:greg@thewesterngroup.net)) subject to a \$35 charge per emailed bill of lading. This charge will be assessed to the customer of record with TSR. TSR reserves the right to reject as an unreasonable request for service, any email forwarding instructions that are illegible, whether due to poor transmission quality, or otherwise. TSR will not accept delivery of forwarding instructions by U.S. Mail, express service, personal delivery, telephone, or otherwise.

When electronic or mechanical devices are used to furnish forwarding instructions and/or empty release information to TSR, the recorded date and time at which the instructions or information are received by TSR will govern.
